Widely recognised throughout her career, Suzanne Archer has received some of Australia's most prestigious awards, including the Wynne Prize (AGNSW, 1994), the Dobell Prize for Drawing (AGNSW, 2010), the Kedumba Drawing Award (2010) and the Eutick Memorial Still Life Award (2018), among numerous other accolades across her career. Major survey and retrospective exhibitions include *The Alchemy of the Studio* (Macquarie University Art Gallery, 2016), *Song of the Cicada* (Campbelltown Arts Centre, 2019; Maitland Regional Art Gallery, 2019), and *The Mermaid's Tail* (Orange Regional Gallery, 2023). Recent solo exhibitions include *Winds of Change, Sands of Time* (Nanda\Hobbs, 2024) and *Notes of a Coastal Scavenger* (Nicholas Thompson Gallery, 2024).

Archer's work is held in many of the nation's most prominent public collections, including the National Gallery of Australia, National Gallery of Victoria, Art Gallery of New South Wales, Artbank, the Australian National University, the Macquarie University Collection, Maitland Regional Art Gallery, Bathurst Regional Art Gallery, Mornington Peninsula Regional Gallery, Redland Art Gallery, HOTA, Newcastle Art Gallery, Wollongong Art Gallery, and numerous university, civic, and private collections across Australia and internationally.
